4. **To review and agree response to TRO consultation for a Kemble Parking Scheme –**  
Following discussion it was proposed to respond with the following:
  - A request to extend the area up to the overland bridge on Windmill Road
  - A request to retain all current proposed bays with the addition of the following:
    - School Road - Additional bays Road towards Fairacre to cater for the school parking (ideally at least 10)
    - Triangle at Washpool Lane - 1/2 bays
    - Layby's on School Road & West Lane by the Beehive – addition of bays
    - West Lane (north of The Oaks) – 1-2 bays
    - Top Farm – bays on the main drag and in the lay-by 6
    - West Hay Grove – 4-6bays
    - Old Manor Gardens – 4 bays
    - Clayfurlong Gardens – bays
    - Old Main Road parallel to A429 near Clayfurlong – bay on east side by the bus stop and 2-3bays on the west side
    - West Lane (from A429) – 2 bays on the pavement outside No. 142
  - A request to remove the proposed bays on triangle where West Lane meets Limes Road
  - A request to exclude of The Oaks from the scheme
  - A request for yellow lines on Windmill Road (Pheasant Hill) to prevent parking at any time
  - A request to amend the proposed scheme operating hours to 9am – 6pm Monday to Friday. Or, if yellow lines on Pheasant Hill cannot be achieved within the TRO, 9am – 6pm Monday to Saturday.

It was also proposed to arrange a leaflet drop to all houses within the affected area to advise residents of the proposal and an information event where residents can find further information and raise queries ahead of the formal GCC consultation. Leaflet production cost up to £100 and delivery cost up to £50.

These actions were seconded, all councillors agreed and **the matter was resolved.**
