Hi Sarah

In response to you request for an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO) for double yellow lines on Pheasant Hill.

This will not be possible as we can only use an ETRO when we do not know what the result of 'trialling' the scheme will be. We know what the result of implementing double yellow line will be... it restricts parking and vehicles will **not** be able to park there.

Also, it is worth stating that an ETRO is a far more complex and time consuming process where the build needs to be paid for and installed upfront and consultation follows, which means that there is a risk we will need to take out the scheme in the future depending on feedback/ comments, which leads to more cost. We also need to consult for 6 months rather than the standard 21 days which requires a lot more officer time to monitor the scheme and deal with more comments over a much longer period.

I hope this answers your query. I have a call with the parish at 3pm today where I can further explain this if needed.
