To receive update on Kemble Residents Parking scheme and agree any actions required Following review of the options available from GCC, the options for a PPA and an RPZ were both dismissed by a majority of councillors and it was proposed that Cllrs Pettit & Collins continue to discuss with GCC a potential Yellow lines scheme that provides restrictions on Windmill Road between Overland Railway Bridge and the top of the hill adjacent to 10 Windmill Road and possibly further restrictions on other parts of Windmill Road and Station Road but such that no permits are required for residents. This was seconded, all remaining councillors agreed and **the matter was resolved.**
