20.238. To hear any contributions from residents

Cirencester Light Railway – query raised over lack of public consultation in the 1st feasibility study.

20.239. To receive any apologies for absence – None received.

20.240. To receive any declarations of interest – None declared.

20.241. To receive updated information on playground (currently closed under 20.226) and agree actions required – it was proposed that, following clarification from Greenfields (the playground inspection company) that no items are defective, the playground should be reopened immediately. It was further proposed that a spend of £997 be approved for the suggested schedule of work for ongoing site maintenance as per the quote received from Greenfields. This we seconded, all remaining councillors agreed and **the matter was resolved.**

20.242. To ratify decision recorded via email for distribution of NDP leaflet to all houses in Kemble & Ewen ahead of the purdah deadline of 26 March 2021 and approve associated costs (up to £150 for printing plus £50 delivery cost) – it was proposed to ratify this decision and approve spend of up to £200. This was seconded, all remaining councillors agreed and **the matter was resolved.**
