Bridge repairs in Kemble

We wanted to let you know that we'll soon be returning to complete repairs to the railway bridge on Station Road.

We'll be working almost continuously at times, including overnight while trains aren't running, to ensure this essential project can be delivered safely and efficiently. An overview of our work and shifts is below, but please note this may change.

Preparation work

This will include cutting back some minor vegetation around the bridge. We'll also set up a compound and start delivering materials and equipment.

Main work

We'll install a new waterproof membrane within the structure, as well as repairing and replacing the stonework where needed.

Saturday 29 May – Friday 25 June	Daytime shifts	Between 8am and 6pm each day
	Overnight shifts	Between 10pm and 8am each day

This work may generate some noise at times, and we want to apologise in advance if we disturb you. We'll have a generator on site and will need to use power tools at times, but we'll work hard to keep any unnecessary noise to a minimum.

As you know we closed the road so we can keep you and our teams safe, and we're sorry for any inconvenience this may have caused. This work should enable us to reopen the road fully from midnight on Friday 2 July.
