Kemble Burial Ground Fees

Effective from January 1, 2024

The table of fees is determined under article 15 of the Local Authorities Cemeteries Order 1997 by the Parish Council of Kemble and Ewen, acting as the Burial Authority for the parish of Kemble and Ewen in Gloucestershire.

Important note, Kemble Burial Ground is nearly full and therefore burials are restricted.

Interment in the Burial Ground is restricted to those who were permanently resident within the area of the parish of Kemble and Ewen, or whose parents are, at the time of the interment, residents of the parish. This will also apply to those who, at the time of death, were residents in hospitals, care homes or sheltered accommodation outside the parish, but were previously permanent residents of the parish.

The parish Council will consider other cases where there is a strong local connection. Each case will be treated individually. In all cases the decision of the Parish Council is final.

Interments

Coffin within a grave

Single burial: £350.00

Second interment (coffin) within the same burial grave: £245.00

Cremated remains (ashes)

Single interment: £175.00 Second interment: £120.00

• Children under 16 years: no charge

Memorials

The right to erect a memorial with an inscription on an existing grave, is granted for a period of 30 years and may be reviewed at that time. Any memorial remains the property of the person erecting it. They have the responsibility to carry out any repairs that may be required.

Memorials for cremated remains (ashes): £175.00

Additional text added to an existing memorial (body or cremation): £44.00
