

## **Annual Parish Meeting Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> May Village Hall**

### **Additional Funds Available to the Parish Council**

The Parish Council will receive £33,000 by way of the Community Infrastructure Levy payable in October 2024. The CIL arises from three current building projects in the area.

“The parish council must use the CIL receipts passed to it to support the development of the parish council’s area by funding the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on the area.”

We are keen to identify projects that could fall within this definition and implement those which are of greatest importance to the parish. Current ideas include a refresh of the Windmill Road playground.
